On 03-02-2017 I stopped Michael Seals for driving with fictitious plates. He was found to be suspended and he could not tell me who owned the vehicle or the plates. I then seized the plates and towed the car for owner verification. I had each occupant exit the vehicle and I then inventoried the vehicle and retrieved any items the occupants wanted. When I checked the bag left in the car by Arthur Adkins it was found to have scales, and pipes used to smoke meth. The items were collected and he was charged with drug paraphernalia. He has pending charges of possession of drugs for the meth that was extracted from the meth pipe that was sent to BCI for testing.
